

# SIEF Medium Equipment Program

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#### Overview

The SIEF Medium Equipment Program (MEP) is designed to address a gap in funding for equipment in the medium range (\$950k-\$4m). This Program aims to enhance capability and capacity and encourage collaboration.

#### **SIEF MEP Objectives**

- 1. To facilitate leading-edge innovation in Australia in areas of greatest strategic impact, based on scientific research;
- 2. To grow both capability and capacity of the equipment stock available to researchers.

If a better price is negotiated then the Applicants are permitted to come back and SIEF may consider additional items to extend the equipment requested. Only in exceptional circumstances will requests be considered for supplementary funding by SIEF.
